3. HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

3.1 Product is classed as IRRITANT

3.2 Risk Phrases: R36/38 Irritating to eyes and skin.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

4.1 Eyes: Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Continue for 10 minutes and seek medical advice if irritation persists.

4.2 Skin: Wash well with water. Remove contaminated clothing.

4.3 Ingestion: Drink milk or water; seek medical advice if feeling unwell.

4.4 Inhalation: If mist or spray is inhaled, remove person to fresh air, rest and keep warm.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

The product is non-flammable and will not support combustion. If drums are involved in a fire, spray with water to keep cool.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Contain spillage with dry earth, sand or granules. Recover by pumping or absorb with granules, scrape up and place into secure containers for disposal as a solid waste. Small spills may be hosed away to foul sewer. Do not allow entry into the surface drainage system.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Store between 0 and 30 °C. Keep in container provided and replace closure after use. Wear protective clothing (see below) when handling neat or diluted product.

When handling neat or diluted product, wear rubber gloves and safety glasses. If exposure to splashes or spray is a possibility, wear a waterproof suit and rubber boots.
